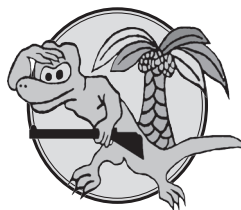

General Information

The members of Silver Dollar Shooters Club would like to welcome you to Odessa and the Florida Trapshooters Association Annual Fall Championships. Saturday evening the gun club will host a cocktail party and a dinner for all our guests.

Tournament Rules

1. A.T.A. rules will govern this tournament and all scores will be included in the official A.T.A. records. By entering these events all shooters agree to accept official decisions and abide by the rules. Violation of A.T.A SAFETY RULES may be cause for disqualification and removal from the grounds.
2. **Florida residents** must present their paid A.T.A. average card with a valid Florida address to be eligible for resident titles and awards. Adult **Florida residents** must also show their valid **Florida Driver's License** or their valid **Florida Voter Registration Card** as proof of residency. No shooter may compete for the Florida Resident Awards unless for the immediate preceding six (6) months he or she has been a **bona fide resident** of the state of Florida and a member in good standing with the F.T.A. In the case of a dispute with respect to the residence of any shooter entering this tournament, the Classification Committee shall rule on a shooter's right to compete as a Florida resident and any ruling of the committee shall be final. **Any complaint must be filed within 30 days of the last day of the shoot.**

Tournament Rules Continued

Fall Handicap Championship Event 6 (100 targets) Sunday, November 15, 2009

3. All shooters must provide paid **A.T.A. average card** with all scores posted and averaged prior to being classified. Previous and current averages plus "known ability" will determine A.T.A. classification as follows:

A.T.A. Five Class System

Class	Singles	Doubles
AA	97% and up	93% and up
A	94% and under 97%	89% and under 93%
B	91% and under 94%	85% and under 89%
C	88% and under 91%	78% and under 85%
D	Under 88%	Under 78%

Shooters with less than 1,000 Singles in the current and previous year must shoot in "Class A" or higher, unless they shoot "**Targets Only**". Shooters with less than 500 Doubles in the current and previous year must shoot in "Class A" or higher, unless they shoot "**Targets Only**". Shooters with less than 1,000 Handicap targets in the current and previous year must shoot on the "Twenty-three Yard Line" or higher, unless they shoot "**Targets Only**". Shooters who have been classified for "**Targets Only**" cannot play purses or options and they are not eligible for trophies, titles or added money! Registered A.T.A. targets shot during Preliminary Events may be used to achieve the minimum target requirements, but the burden is on each shooter to report for reclassification

4. Please declare your **A.T.A. special category** at the time that you are classified and verify your category each time you enter an event to ensure that you are included in the competition. Special categories are Lady, Sub-Junior (under 15 years), Junior (15 to 17 years), Veteran (65 to 69 years) and Senior Veteran (70 years and up).

5. To prevent unnecessary delays, please be at your proper starting trap ready to shoot when your squad is called. Squads cannot wait for absent shooters and must start without them. A shooter missing more than this or her first sub-event will be scratched and may re-enter through the cashier only. Shooters may **make up one sub-event** on the practice trap. A shooter cannot re-squad by just joining another squad on the line that has an open position. If the rules and procedures are unclear, please consult the Tournament Officials for assistance.

6. Ties in Preliminary Singles and Doubles events will carry over to the next like event. and be decided by Sub event. Ties in Handicap events may flip (if all shooters involved agree) or shoot-off. Each shooter will be called for a shoot-off three (3) times. If a shooter does not report for a shoot-off, he or she will forfeit the title and the award.

7. Shooters are limited to winning only one award per event. When a shooter's score qualifies for more than one award, **the burden is on the shooter to notify the F.T.A. Secretary-Treasurer within fifteen (15) minutes** of the posting of the last score of his or her award choice. Where F.T.A. awards are provided, Florida residents may participate in a class shoot-off, and if unsuccessful in the shoot-off, may fall back to their category award. Upon completion of the event, please collect awards and be photographed for the *Trap and Field* magazine article.

8. In addition to the entry fee, all shooters must pay the daily A.T.A. (\$2.00) and F.T.A. (\$2.00) fees. A Florida Hall of Fame Fee (\$.50) will be collected from all shooters when they enter the **Fall Handicap Championship Event**. Only U.S. currency will be accepted. Entry fees are non-refundable unless an event is canceled by the Host Club Management. Entries will close when the last squad takes the line.

9. Options and purses are **not compulsory** and may be played at the time of entry only. Changes or cancellations will not be allowed after an entry has been paid. Pay-off sheets will be posted for all events by the Host Club's computer operators who will not be responsible for errors in scores after pay-off sheets have been posted. **Please check your scores!**

10. All **Lewis Purses** will be divided one class each nine (9) entries, or major portion thereof, with three (3) classes maximum and will be paid 60/40 percentage system (ties will divide). All **percentage purses** will be paid 50/30/20 percentage system (ties will divide). All **class purses** will be paid 60/40 percentage system and each class will shoot for its own money (ties will divide). All **handicap yardage group purses** will be paid 60/40 percentage system and each **handicap yardage group** (19-21, 22-24, 25-27) will shoot for its own money. The **Florida Option** is a Ten Way Purse with \$1.00 charged for each 100 (1), each 75 (2), each 50 (3) and each 25 (4) and will be paid one money per division (ties will divide). When less than five (5) shooters enter a purse or option, the purse or option will be eliminated and the money refunded.

11. Only regulation A.T.A. trap loads may be shot. Factory shells and reloads may be used; however, suspect shells will be subject to challenge by Tournament Officials and all violators will be disqualified. Keep **guns unloaded** until on the line and it is **safe to shoot**. Test shots will not be permitted on the program trap fields. Please do not pick up empty hulls.

12. Shooters breaking 100 straight or 200 straight without carry over will be awarded a Florida Gator 100 straight or 200 straight pin by the Florida A.T.A. Delegate or the F.T.A. Secretary.

13. The Host Club and Tournament Officials reserve the right to change the **Official Program** for this tournament. The Host Club reserves the right to reject, refund or disqualify anyone who interferes with the harmony, conduct or sportsmanship of the tournament.

14. The **Fall Gun Club Team Race** will run concurrently during the **Fall Singles Championships**. Only Florida residents may enter **and must provide a current membership card for the F.T.A. gun club for which he or she will be shooting**. F.T.A. gun clubs may enter as many teams as desired, but each member is limited to only one team. The team posting the highest total score (200 targets plus advantage points, per team member) will receive individual awards. All teams must be entered prior to the event through the F.T.A. secretary who will provide entry forms for all team races.

15. The **Fall Husband and Wife Team Race** will run concurrently during the Fall Singles Championships. The husband and wife with the highest score (400 targets total plus advantage points) will become the Champion and will receive a team award. All team members must be Florida residents. Team members must enter prior to the event through the F.T.A. secretary who will provide entry forms for all team races.

16. The **Fall Parent and Child Team Race** will run concurrently during the Fall Singles Championships. Each family member may participate in only one parent/child team. The child must be a Junior (17 years or younger). The Parent and Child Team with the highest score (400 targets total plus advantage points) will become the Champion and will receive a team award. All team members must be Florida residents. Team members must enter prior to the event through the F.T.A. secretary who will provide entry forms for all team races.

17. The **Fall Challenge Team Race** will run concurrently during the Fall Singles Championships. The Team posting the highest combined scores (200 targets plus advantage points, per shooter) will receive individual awards. All team members must be Florida residents. Team members must enter prior to the event through the F.T.A. secretary who will provide entry forms for all team races. Each team may be composed of any class shooter and shooters may only shoot on one team.
